## Forbes ranks Tashir Group among Russia's Top 200 companies

The group also won the contract to build a number of transport hubs in Moscow and expanded its retail chains," Forbes writes.

The Forbes Top 200 list ranks Russia's largest privately owned companies. Tashir Group has been part of the rankings for the past 12 years.
